EXISTING MASTER PLAN

DATA AND MAPS

- Census Data is produced at the strongest confidence interval for the decennial census years (1990, 2000, 2010). However, the most recent census data comes from the American Community Survey and is available at 5-year estimates at a relatively high confidence interval. This data comes in 2010-2014 data for Cleveland Township. Is there preference on data sources?
